

PRINTING FULL PAGE SIZE - Borderless Printing

When borderless is selected, a Printer will Fill the Whole Page without a white border.

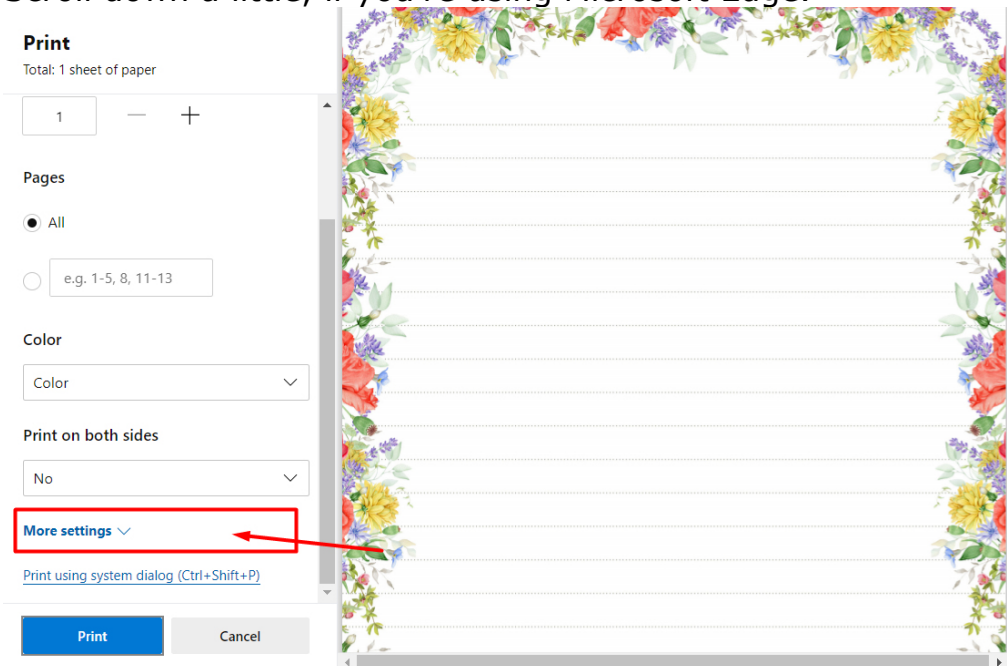
1. Open [this test page](#).

2. Click **Print**. This will bring up the print window you normally use.

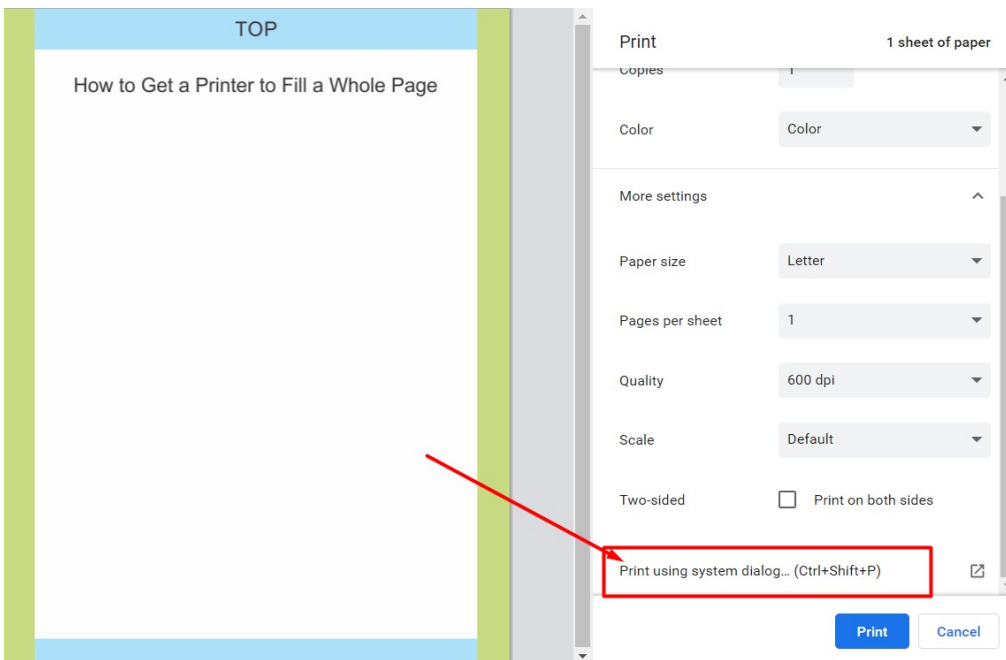


3. Click the **MORE SETTINGS** link.

Scroll down a little, if you're using Microsoft Edge.

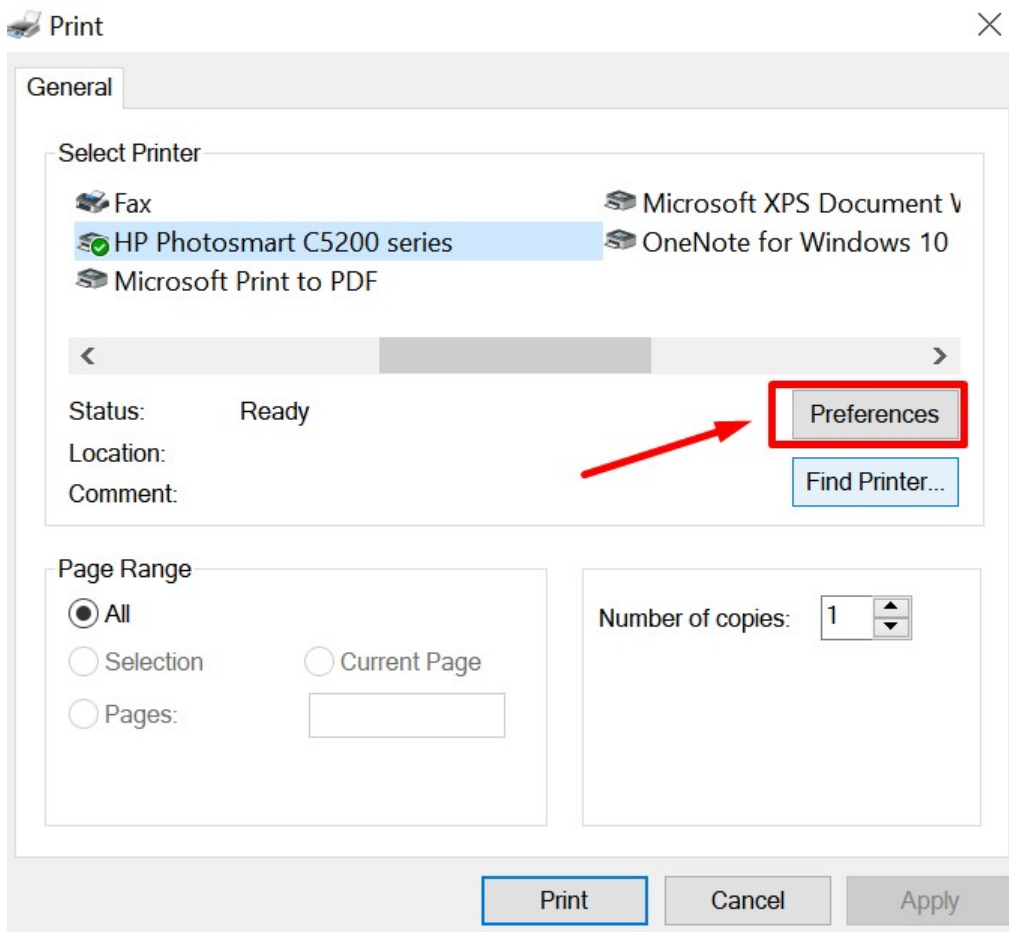


4. Scroll down to "**Print using system dialog**" and click on it.



5. Click on **PREFERENCES**.

The printer menu will open. I am using a HP printer, your printer menu may look slightly different.



6. Click the box beside "**borderless**". and select **PRINT AT ACTUAL SIZE**. Click **OK**.

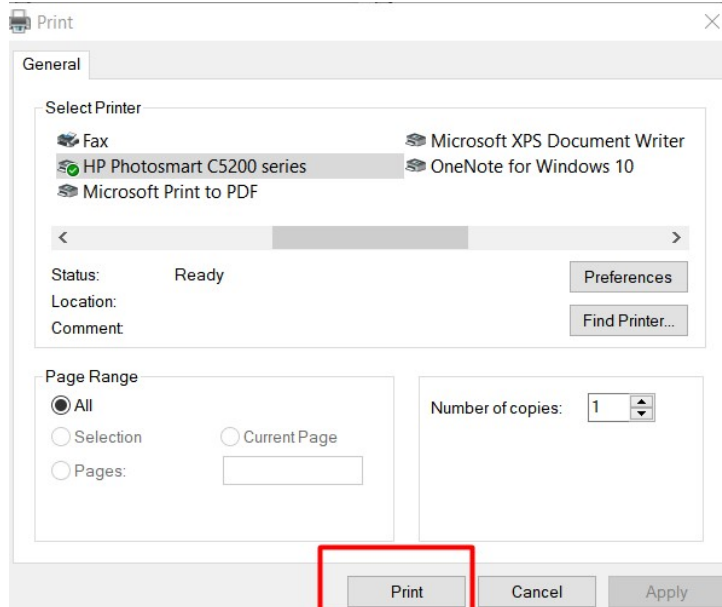

In Acrobat Reader, this setting is saved and you only need to change it once.
