## PRINTING FULL PAGE SIZE - Borderless Printing

When borderless is selected, a Printer will Fill the Whole Page without a white border.

## 1. Open this test page.

2. Click Print. This will bring up the print window you normally use.

3. Click the MORE SETTINGS link.

Scroll down a little, if you're using Microsoft Edge.

4. Scroll down to "Print using system dialog" and click on it.

## 5. Click on PREFERENCES.

The printer menu will open. I am using a HP printer, your printer menu may look slightly different.

6. Click the box beside "borderless ". and select PRINT AT ACTUAL SIZE. Click OK.
